Dr Ivan Dimov Ivanov coordinates WHO global action on workers' health and leads current projects on strengthening the performance of health systems in protecting and promoting the health of workers, including scaling up workers' health coverage, development of national plans and profiles on workers' health and the training of primary care providers and the protection of occupational health in outbreaks and public health emergencies.

Dr Ivanov started working at the WHO in 2000, first in the Regional Office for Europe as programme manager for environmental health policies and occupational health. In 2005, he was transferred to WHO Headquarters to strengthen the global occupational health programme. Prior to joining WHO, Dr Ivanov was deputy chief medical officer and senior adviser in occupational health at the Ministry of Health of his native country, Bulgaria. He is a medical doctor, specialist in occupational health, and studied health administration in the Ministry of Welfare, Japan. Dr Ivanov obtained his PhD in sociology of health and environment from Michigan State University, USA, where he had a faculty appointment as adjunct professor at the Institute of International Health.
